The Armenia School Foundation USA Ends 2008 Successfully By Refurnishing Seven Schools in Armenia and Karabagh.

Glendale, California – The Armenia School Foundation (ASF USA), a non-profit organization dedicated to refurnishing small and remote schools in Armenia, is proud to announce the completion of seven more school projects in 2008.

“This year marked an important and successful year for ASF” stated Armen Abrahamian, Chairman of the Board. “Through our combined efforts and successful fundraising events, such as the 5th Anniversary gala held in May, ASF managed to raise over \$100,000 to furnish seven additional schools in 2008”.

The overall assistance that the foundation has provided to schools in remote areas of Armenia and Karabagh this year was \$68,810. ASF delivered 609 student chairs and desk sets (along with 64 teacher sets and 67 blackboards) for 1,218 students in various regions of the country.
